

## The Journey of Persistence

The final victory in 2025 was not a sudden event, but the culmination of years of strategic, unrelenting pressure. The last five years, in particular, saw our community mobilise like never before, laying the final groundwork for this historic win.





### Building Unstoppable Momentum

Our strategy was simple: be everywhere. We maintained a constant, visible presence that politicians and the industry could not ignore. Through heatwaves and winter chills, our dedicated volunteers ran stalls at the Hyde Park Festival, the Perth Vegan Expo, and local events like the Perth Makers Market. Each conversation, each t-shirt sold, and each petition signed added another voice to our chorus demanding change.

### **Bearing Witness:**

We never stopped fighting for the voiceless. When we received reports of cattle being loaded in extreme heat at Fremantle Port in late December 2024, we were there to bear witness and condemn the systemic failures that allow such cruelty to persist. These actions reinforced the urgent need for an end to the entire live export industry.

Every rally, every market stall, and every email to an MP built the wave that finally broke down the walls of political indifference and secured this legislative victory







## Keep The Sheep Here: Unity for Sheep

As the 2025 federal election loomed, we knew the live export industry and its political allies would launch a desperate, last-ditch effort to overturn the legislated ban. To counter this, we needed a campaign that was clear, powerful, and unified.

Together with our valued partners—RSPCA Australia, Animals Australia, and the Australian Alliance for Animals—we launched the #KeepTheSheepHere campaign.

This wasn't just a slogan; it was a comprehensive political strategy with a central, positive message. The campaign created a powerful public hub at <u>keepthesheephere.com.au</u>, which served to:

- **Empower Voters:** We armed the public with clear, factual information, contrasting the declining, cruel live trade with the thriving, humane, and more valuable local sheep meat processing industry.
- Cut Through the Noise: Through targeted digital advertising, a high-impact mobile billboard roaming Perth, and easy-to-understand political scorecards, we ensured our message reached voters in the most critical electorates.
- **Present a Better Future:** The campaign masterfully framed the issue not as a loss, but as a choice between a cruel past and a kinder, more prosperous future for both Australian farmers and animals.

The #KeepTheSheepHere campaign was the ultimate expression of our collective power. It demonstrated that when the animal welfare movement stands together, we can successfully defend our progress and secure a compassionate future.







# Holding Power to Account

We kept the pressure on at a political level. We consistently called out the WA Government for the four-year delay in modernising the state's outdated Animal Welfare Act, supporting petitions and campaigns to expedite this crucial review. This demonstrated our commitment to protecting animals at every stage of the supply chain.

When the 2025 Federal Election was called, we were ready. Our campaign was swift, targeted, and effective:



We designed and distributed thousands of Political Party Scorecard Stickers and Flyers, empowering the public to make an informed choice at the ballot box.



Thanks to our incredible donors, a mobile billboard carrying the "Keep the Sheep Here" message circulated through Perth, ensuring our campaign was seen by tens of thousands.



Our passionate supporters held a peaceful and powerful Counter-Convoy event in Perth, showing the true depth of community support for the phase-out, dwarfing the industry's protest.

The victory for sheep has shown us that change is not only possible, but inevitable when a compassionate community stands together. We must now use this momentum to build a future where NO animal is forced to suffer on a live export vessel.

We turn our attention to all other animals that are exported from Australia each year. We will expose the suffering they endure from heat stress and inhumane slaughter and build a case for this cruel trade to end.
